Spiritual State of the World's Children: Summary Table, Peru

Older students, ages 16-18, were not represented in sufficient numbers for valid statistical interpretation of responses by age. The survey is heavily skewed towards the younger population, with only 25% of participants aged 16 or older.

That percentage drops with increased population density. 72% live with both natural parents. 55% report they are very close to their fathers.
